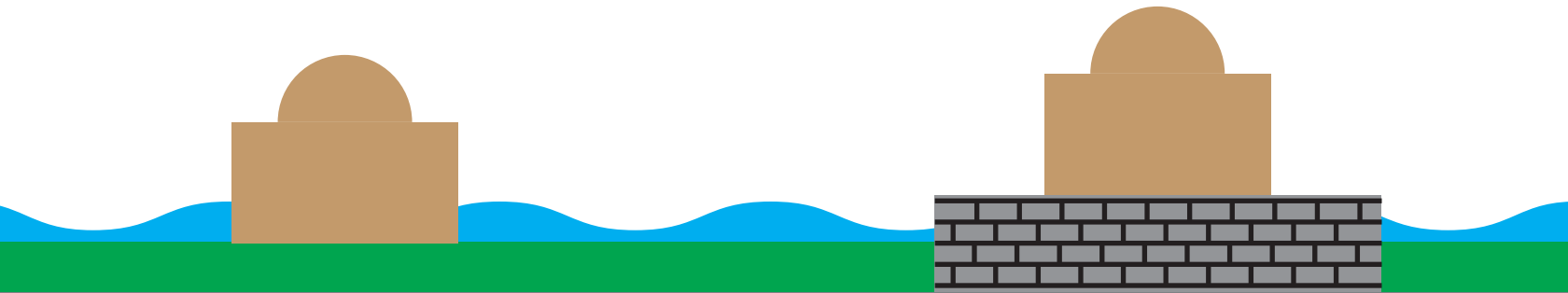

Flood prone *to* **Flood resistant**



One of the most immediate driving forces behind the Fayetteville St. Masjid development project is the fact that the current building is three feet below the flood plain. Substantial rains often lead to flooding of the building, suspending prayer services and damaging resources including carpet in the prayer hall. To permanently correct this problem, the project aims at rebuilding our Masjid three feet higher than current floor elevation.

Parking

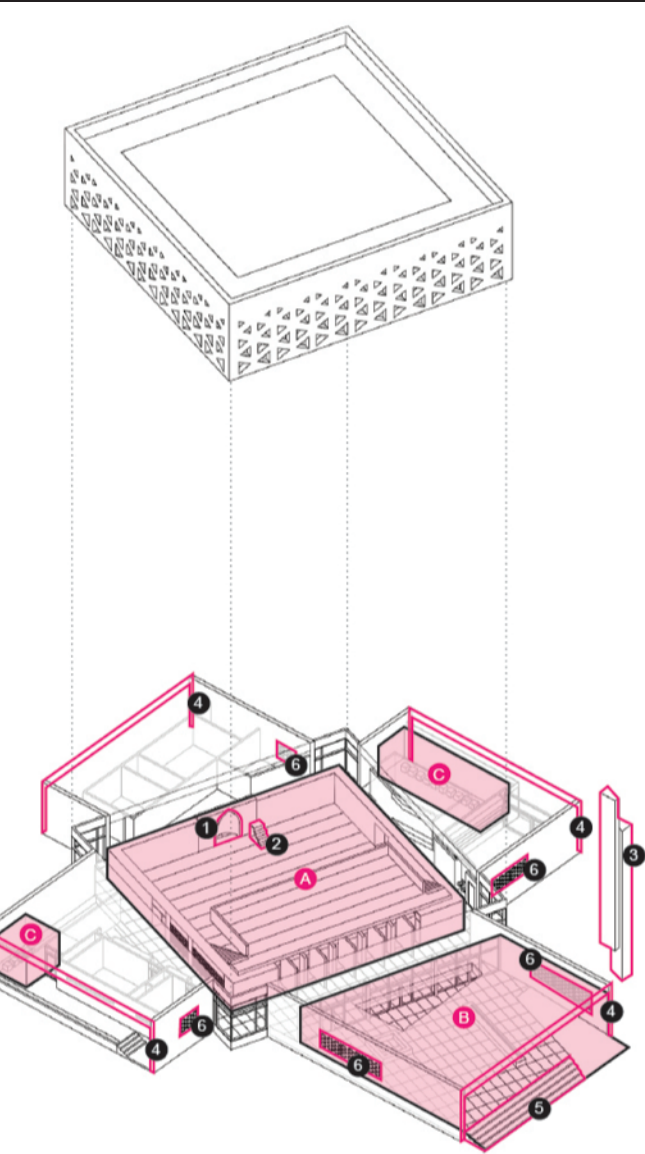
Based on the size of the prayer hall, there would be 116 required parking spaces. The majority of the parking spaces would be pushed away from the floodway to allow for a large landscape element between them.
