Statements from the Chairman and Imams of Jamaat Ibad Ar-Rahman



Dear community member, Assalamu Alaikum.

We pray that you and your family are well by the grace of Allah (SWT). As in previous years, we reach out to you to inform that Jamaat Ibad Ar-Rahman (JIAR) will be conducting its annual fundraiser on **Saturday March 11, 2023**. This is the most significant yearly event where you come together to support your Masjids and community programs and projects. You are cordially invited to this blessed event and join the fundraiser dinner with two esteemed scholars that you have known for a long time – **Shk. Abderroof Alkhawaldeh** and **Dr. Ihab Saad**.

By the grace of Allah SWT, our community has grown significantly in number and diversity in the past several years and we are blessed with two Masjids currently accommodating close to 1000 people for Friday *Jummuah* prayers in four shifts. The greater Durham area has recently welcomed many refugee families from around the world. With the current influx of people moving to North Carolina from other states, we expect that our community will grow further. With this continued growth, the funding needs for improvement projects, community welfare, and Masjid operations



at JIAR have also increased. The community has hired two fulltime Imams to meet religious needs. However, it further requires increasing its capacity to serve the community effectively by hiring fulltime administrative and support staff. Needless to say, the community is in dire need of Islamic schools to educate our children with Islamic morals, behaviors, and practices. Therefore, we are embarking on a plan for an improved and extended schooling system in the community. We request that you support us in such endeavors.

Dear community, it is your donations collected on Fridays and during annual fundraisers that allow us to meet our major expenses for JIAR operations and community services throughout the year. In 2022, the total operational expense to run its Masjids, school activities, and welfare programs including Sadaqah was close to \$600,000. Additionally, as we informed you last year, the Phase 1 activities of the Fayetteville Masjid building project (interior renovation for a new kitchen, and upgrading bathrooms, funeral home, and common spaces) and other projects relating to improvements in Durham Muslim Cemetery, and the Parkwood Masjid roof repair, costed your Jamaat approximately \$300,000, bringing the total expense for 2022 close to \$1.0 Million. We anticipate that the need of funds in 2023 will be substantially higher if the Phase 2 of the Fayetteville Masjid renovation (exterior remodeling and roof replacement), and other critically important projects like new or improved Islamic Schools, parking lot repairs, playground, etc. are undertaken. While the funds collected for the Fayetteville Masjid construction can be used for its renovation, the new funds needed for other projects alone are in the amount of \$370,000 (see below).

We are counting on your sincere duas and generous donations to meet these goals, *inshaAllah*. Donations in the path of Allah may be the safeguard for you and your family, as Allah (SWT) says in the Qur'an (*Al-Bagara, verse 274*):

"Those who (in charity) spend of their goods by night and by day, in secret and in public, have their reward with their Lord; on them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve"



JIAR Facilities and Services

The JIAR operates two Masjids in the Durham area with space for 1000 people to pray in congregation. Both Masjids are operated under the single management of the JIAR Board. Various community services including five daily prayers, Jummah prayers, Taraweeh prayers, educational programs, Islamic speeches by JIAR Imams and visiting scholars, Sunday School, Qur'an School, Full-time Islamic School (Al-Huda Academy in collaboration with MAS), Funeral Home, and Muslim Cemetery are offered at JIAR facilities. JIAR financially helps many Muslim brothers and sisters in need including refugees through its Sadaqa program throughout the year. Organizing programs for Islamic Dawah to non-Muslims in the area is one of the key activities of JIAR.




Other than leading daily prayers and Jumuah prayers, Imam's leadership and services include but not limited to:


- Leading/teaching Al-Misbah Quran Academy.

JIAR's collaboration with ICNA Relief and Zakat Foundation continues to serve the community members in need.

ICNA Relief - JIAR Services in 2022

Hunger Prevention Program Supporting NC

- > 240 Families and 1000 individuals served with non-perishable food
- > 500 Lb of fresh meat (including udhiya meat) distributed
- ➤ 220,454 Lb of non-perishable food provided to NC communities

50% provided in Durham





Back 2 School

- 900 Backpacks provided to 13 communities in NC (95 in Durham)
- One classroom grant was awarded to a school in Charlotte





Health Services

- > 10 Free Community Health Clinics were organized for community
- ➤ About 80-82 people served at Parkwood and Fayetteville locations
- Community benefited from free physicians' counseling, blood sugar testing, blood glucose testing, lipid panel testing, blood pressure testing





Transitional House for Homeless Women

- Providing temporary shelter to homeless women and their kids (younger than 10 years old)
- 8 families are currently accommodated
- Try to bring them back into life where they can earn by themselves and be part of community once again

- Al-Misbah was established in 2013 with the aim of serving the community's need: providing Islamic education and teaching the Noble Qur'an to our children in Durham and its vicinity.
- > Al-Misbah is a self-paced program, and students' motivation and parents' participation are used to help students reach their goals.
- ➤ It resumed its activities in August 2021 after a disruption due to the COVID outbreak. It currently has an enrollment of close to 140 students.

AMMAR BIN YASSER (ABY) SUNDAY SCHOOL

Jamaat Ibad Ar-Rahman hosts Ammar Bin Yasser (ABY) weekend school at its Parkwood facility located at 5122 Revere Rd., Durham, NC 27713 to allow enhancing Islamic education to children in Durham and its vicinity. It is a cooperative project initiated with a merger of JIAR's An-Noor Sunday School effective from 2016 school year

under an agreement with MAS (Muslim American Society), which currently administers and manages

the school.

The school enrolls children (4 years old till K8) and runs every Sunday from 11:00 AM to 2:45 PM during September to May. The school time is divided into four segments to effectively teach Quran, Arabic and Islamic Studies along with the Recess/Prayer/Lunch time. Each segment is about forty-five minutes.

The school values the importance of understanding Arabic, Quran and Islamic teachings for all of its students and community members and for this reason

the school policy never allows refusal of any students because of inability to pay the full tuition. It has enrolled about 81 students in the current school year, Alhamdulillah.





The school is run solely by volunteers who serve as teachers and administrators to seek Allah's (subhanu wa ta'ala) pleasure.



Funeral Home and Cemetery

Jamaat Ibad Ar Rahman operates the first Muslim Funeral Home in the North Carolina. With Allah's grace and your kind support Muslims now have facility that provides washing and burial services following Islamic rituals. The Durham Muslim Cemetery is located within a mile from the Fayetteville Masjid.

The time immediately following the death of a loved one can be overwhelming, with grief and bereavement complicated by the seemingly endless number of tasks. For non-Muslim, losing a Muslim family member can cause additional confusion on how to proceed.

Jamaat Ibad Ar-Rahman helps during these difficult times by arranging everything from picking up the body from the hospital, performing the ritual prayer on the body of the deceased (*Salaatul Janazah*), burying the body at a Muslim cemetery, and finally completing all the required legal paperwork.
